### REGISTRATION FEES:

Registration Fee during February 2019 is \$175.  
Registration Fee March 1 to March 13 is \$225.  
Registration Fee after March 13 is \$275.  
*The registration fee is nonrefundable and non-transferable.*

### PAYMENT MANAGEMENT OPTIONS

- *OPTION 1:* Single payment in full, due by June 7, 2019. (3% discount on all tuition.)
- *OPTION 2:* FACTS 10-month payment plan, July–April. (Tuition is paid in advance of the month of education.)
- *OPTION 3:* Combination: Pay any amount to reduce your monthly payments, and then use FACTS 10-month payment plan, July–April. (Tuition is paid in advance of the month of education.)

### FACTS MANAGEMENT INFORMATION

- FACTS is a third-party tuition management company that automatically deducts tuition payments from your checking account or credit card on the 5<sup>th</sup> or 20<sup>th</sup> of the month. (A 2.75% fee applies to credit card charges.)
- Setting up your FACTS agreement is as simple as clicking on the e-Cashier link located at the bottom of the Academy’s home page ([www.LCAky.com](http://www.LCAky.com)) or the FACTS link on the school’s RenWeb page.
- Once your FACTS agreement is set up, it can be carried over from school year to school year electronically.
- Extra payments may be made online or to the school office at any time to reduce the monthly FACTS payment.
- Parents without a checking account who must pay tuition throughout the year at the school office must pay a \$50 fee.

### FINANCIAL POLICY

- Since the school establishes a budget, hires teachers, and must continue to pay faculty based on registration totals, students withdrawing (or expelled) any time before the end of the first semester will owe one-half of the full year’s tuition. Students withdrawing (or expelled) anytime during the second semester will owe the full year’s tuition. Any further credit balance on the account at the time of withdrawal will be refunded.
- A student will not be admitted to class if payments are one month in arrears. Payments that are more than 45 days late must be paid at the school office, not through FACTS. LCA will assess a once a month \$25 charge for all checks returned by your bank for any reason and for any tuition payment refused by your bank, or a late fee of \$25 for tuition payments not received by the close of the 5<sup>th</sup> or 20<sup>th</sup> day, unless an alternative arrangement is mutually agreed upon in advance. (FACTS also charges a once a month \$30 charge for any returned payment.) If two FACTS payments are refused and/or checks are returned by the bank, the account may be on a cash basis only.
- All tuition and fees must be paid up to date by May 5 in order for a student to attend classes, take exams, or graduate. No school records or graduation diploma will be released for any student when there is an outstanding balance on the student’s account or other indebtedness (after-school care, music lessons, etc.).

### ADDITIONAL FEES

- **Student Textbooks:** Students are required to purchase their own textbooks which are sold by LCA at Orientation in August. The cost for textbooks varies but is approximately \$200 to \$360 per grade.
- **Student Uniforms:** LCA students are required to purchase a pant/skirt and shirt uniform through Shaheen's Department Store. (*Boys' pants and girls' jumpers may be purchased elsewhere, but must match closely to the Shaheen's uniform pant/jumper.*) Clothing may be purchased at Shaheen's Outer (944 Breckenridge ♦ 502-899-1550). Please contact the store for pricing information.
- **Sports Fee:** Any grade 7 – 12 student who wishes to participate in soccer, volleyball, and/ or basketball must pay a sports fee of \$125. Athletes who wish to participate solely in cross country and/or track (including elementary students) must pay a \$30 sports fee for each sport. The maximum sports fee charged in one year is \$125; this amount will cover all sports the athlete wishes to play during one school year.
- **Extended School Day (ESD):** Fees are calculated on an hourly per day basis and are billed monthly on RenWeb. Fees are as follows: 1 Child = \$5 per hour; 2 Children = \$8 per hour; 3 Children = \$10 per hour; 4 Children = \$12 per hour.
- **Miscellaneous Expenses:** During the course of the school year other expenses are involved for various services or activities such as grade 7-12 clubs, academic competitions, class functions, etc. Most of these expenses are optional. The school makes every effort to keep these expenses to a minimum.
- **Returned Check Fee:** LCA will assess a \$25 charge for each check returned by your bank for any reason and for any tuition payment refused by your bank.
- **Non-FACTS Fee:** Parents without a checking account who must pay tuition at the school office throughout the school year pay a \$50 fee.
- **Class Fees:** Family and Consumer Sciences has a \$50 class fee to help cover the cost of foods prepared in the class. Biology has a \$10 class fee to cover dissection expenses. Keyboarding has a \$15 fee to cover printing expenses (in addition to the textbook rental fee). Spanish class has a \$25 fee to assist with the Rosetta Stone subscription.
- **Graduation Fee:** Twelfth grade graduates pay a \$20 graduation fee, and kindergarten graduates pay a \$15 graduation fee, *due by April 20, to offset expenses for their graduation ceremony.*
