



“Welcome to the 2019 Quentin Road Summer Camp”

Dear Families,

Welcome to the 2019 Quentin Road Summer Camp! We would like to share some helpful tips:

- Please bring a backpack with a complete change of clothes each day that your child attends camp. Put your child's name on the backpack. Spills do happen!
- Bring a modest one-piece swimsuit and towel for the outdoor waterslide on the following days each month (refer to the summer activity calendar for more details):
 - Mondays & Thursdays in June
 - Tuesdays & Fridays in July
 - Wednesdays & Thursdays in August
- Kids entering 1st grade and up can bring their swimsuits for the weekly indoor “Pool Party” beginning June 11th.
- All portable game systems, electronic devices, cell phones and mp3 players should be left at home.
- Please apply sunscreen to your child before dropping them off at camp. If needed, we will reapply it in the afternoon. You do not need to send sunscreen to camp. We will provide it.
- Children entering 2nd grade and up are welcome to bring their own lunch to camp as long as it doesn't contain any nut products. Younger children should not bring food from home (unless it is for medical reasons) due to the large number of children with food allergies and the need for adult supervision of their allergies. Please keep in mind that we do not provide refrigeration or microwave use for campers' lunches.
- Payments are due the 1st day of each week that your child attends camp. Payments can be made at camp with cash or check. Credit/debit payments can be made at camp or online, but do have a 2-3% convenience fee added.
- Please help us by keeping the children safe and not sending any nut products to camp.
- Check your emails and turn on your Brightwheel notifications – this is how we will communicate any pertinent camp information to you.
- We require a three week written notice for any schedule changes. You can submit these changes online at www.qrcp.org.
- We can only administer medication if we have a medicine authorization form filled out by your doctor. These forms are available in the school lobby and on our website.
- Every child is required to submit an Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination form before they attend.
